Stainless Trim for Modular Furniture

Project Description

A VA Hospital in the Washington D.C. area wanted to install nurses stations that could weather the wear and tear these high-traffic environments typically experience. The customer liked the flexibility of standard modular furniture, but was concerned that it would quickly be damaged. To provide a lasting solution that would optimize the hospital’s investment, we created custom stainless-steel trim that could withstand the rigors of this demanding space and easily adapt when needs change.

Process

After viewing the stainless-steel trim we created for applications at Duke University Hospital and NYU Langone Health, the designer on this project knew that a StudioCraft solution would be ideal for the hospital. We worked with our dealer partner to design highly durable stainless trim for the systems furniture frames that were standard for the hospital system. To ensure the trim would be easy to install, we tested it out in our shop ahead of time.

Solution

To create cladding that would protect the panels, we used 16-gauge steel—not the thin-gauge sheet metal that’s typically specified. In addition, the cladding is modular. It attaches in nearly the same way standard product does but in a more secure fashion.

When the time comes for a product upgrade it will be simple for an installer to switch the trim out, saving time and money, because there’s no need to order a completely new station. The best part? Because our product only replaced the base cover and bottom 8-inch tile, the remainder of each station is standard product—beneficial for the hospital and our dealer partner.
